HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 81

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DECLARING APRIL 12, 2018, AS
2 REMANUFACTURING (REMAN) DAY.

3 WHEREAS, remanufacturing is a comprehensive and rigorous
4 industrial process by which a previously sold, leased, used, worn
5 or nonfunctional product or part is returned to a
6 "same-as-when-new" or better condition, from both a quality and
7 performance perspective, through a controlled, reproducible and
8 sustainable process; and

9 WHEREAS, remanufacturing has been recognized by leading
10 universities, research institutions, and manufacturers around the
11 world as the highest form of recycling, by reducing green house
12 gas production, saving energy and reclaiming end of life products;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, by encouraging businesses, state agencies, nonprofit
15 organizations, schools and individuals to celebrate Reman Day
16 2018, we can further promote remanufacturing as environmentally
17 friendly and economically efficient; and



18 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to focus the
19 nation's attention on the benefits of remanufacturing, businesses,
20 educational institutions, and nonprofit organizations have joined
21 together to celebrate Reman Day and are encouraging their
22 colleagues, friends and families, and their communities to learn
23 more about the benefits of remanufactured products:

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
25 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
26 THEREIN, That we do hereby declare Thursday, April 12, 2018, as
27 Remanufacturing (Reman) Day 2018.
